

Its founder and Chairman, T. David Petite was bestowed the honor of being included in the USPTO's 2014 Inventor Collectible Trading Card Series. David was specifically recognized by the Patent Office for his contribution to the wireless and mobile phone industry. He was the 17th collectible trading card in the pack. Other inventors have included Thomas Edison, Nikola Tesla, Abraham Lincoln and Sir Alex John Jefferys. The Inventor Collectible Trading Card Series allows the patent office to recognize the critical work of America's inventors and entrepreneurs, and the benefits they create in the economy of the United States of America. T. When they brought forth their ideas he was intrigued to hear many new ideas including “shoes that extended as pupils grew – the driving force behind the invention being to save their parents money”. David said – “I love working with the next generation of entrepreneurs. They are the ones who will help drive our economy. I was honored when a mother of one of the students came up to me and said *You made such a difference to my son - now he knows what he wants to be, he is going to be an engineer.*” On that same trip David received one of the most precious gifts he has been presented – it was a piece of art about Native Americans developed by the children of the Lucile S. Bruner Elementary School, and he has it at home today to remind him of such a wonderful experience and the creative minds of those children. He sincerely hopes they go on to achieve the potential they showed that day in their school.
